

You Don't Have an AI Problem. You Have a **Readiness Problem.**

Before you evaluate any AI product, you need to know whether your business can actually use one. Five questions, ten minutes, no data science team required.

The five questions, in order

01 Data — do you have it, and is it usable?

02 Process — is the task actually documented?

03 Governance — who checks the AI's work?

04 Team — can staff catch its mistakes?

05 Measurement — how will you know it worked?

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Data readiness is checked first, always.

Every other dimension depends on it. A well-governed, well-staffed organisation with clean processes still cannot compensate for missing or unreliable data.

Ten minutes is enough to find out.
